

My name is Daniel Nuvita, I am crowned indigenous Kógui of the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta in Colombia, which is located in South America.

I am a survivor of a culture of over 1000 years of existence in the world, now reduced to a few survivors, which due to the Spanish conquest were forced to hide in the highest peaks of the mountains.

The Kóguis, who is the community to which I belong is one of the indigenous groups more preserved its customs and traditions, because there is very little contact with civilization has, as they are far removed from them and access civilization is very difficult.

My family thanks God met by North American missionaries, who have supported my community and my life, because with their support I could study at a Christian school in a town called Santa Marta, finished school in 2006 being one of the best students and prominent, very young I liked medicine, as in the community to which I belong there still a Kógui doctor who can help and provide a health service. Many Indians who die for lack of medical attention deficit and largely because of diseases that are curable today.

This was my main motivation to study medicine and in 2007 started this race, which I thought I could not study, however thanks to support North American missionaries and missionary in Korea, and I have come forward much of my career , however, has been complicated because the economic costs are often insufficient to keep going, however trusted God to finish the race and be able to buy all the medical supplies and basic tools to start helping my people, for financial support people who financed my studies for health reasons can not continue to do so, so the path becomes more difficult and yet I know that God Himself must open the way and give me the tools to go forward with my studies and sleep to help an entire community that needs not only a doctor but also the word of God and has transformed my life to make me a tool of it.
